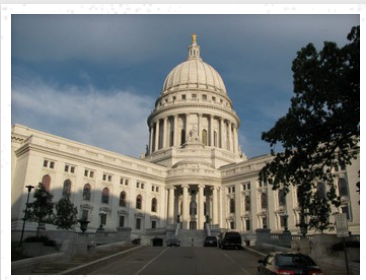
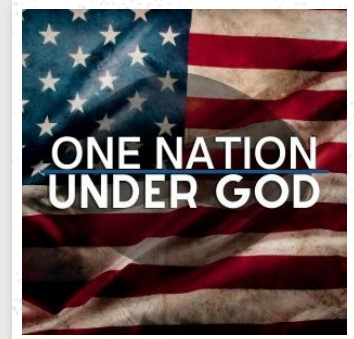
BASKETBALL SIGN-UP

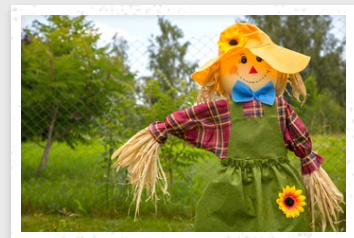

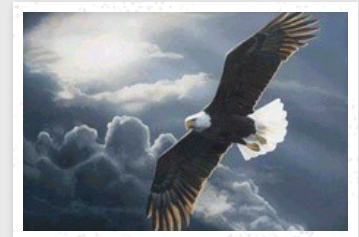


10 AUTUMN LEAF CRAFTS IDEAS FOR KIDS
