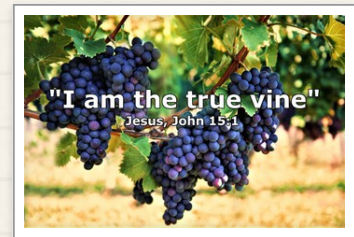

2023 24 First Day of School




Bang Bang Shrimp

3K, 4K and Kindergarten Current Immunization Records

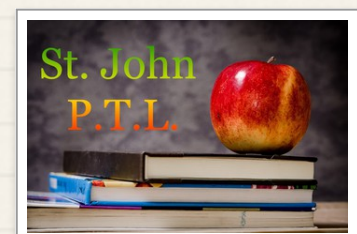

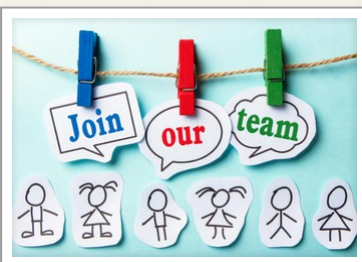




The Next School Board Meeting

through 5th grade meets in the church library. If you have any questions, contact Kris Prah at ckprahl@frontier.com or 715-581- 4045.

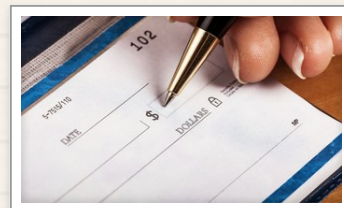
