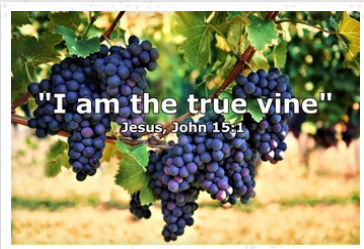
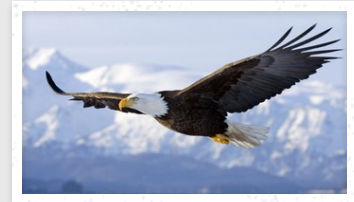

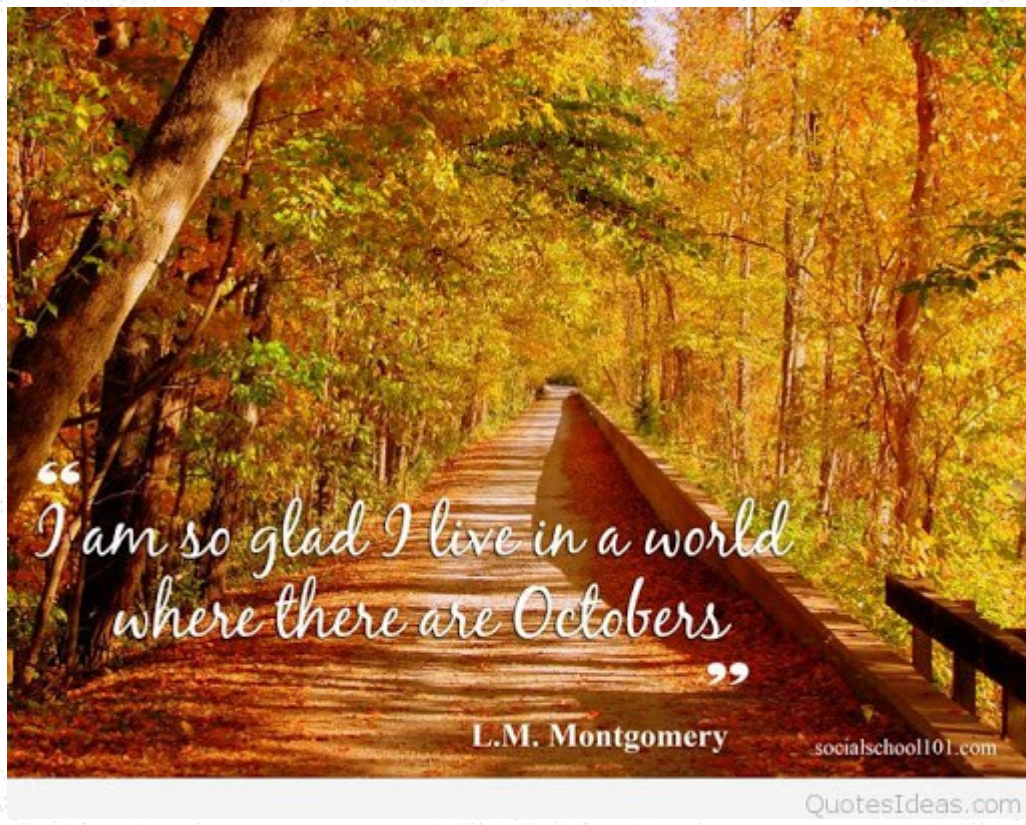
VOLLEYBALL TOURNAMENT RESULTS!

SECOND ANNUAL CHRISTMAS SHOPPING MALL

The purpose is to have a shopping place for children to purchase affordable, inexpensive gifts for Mom, Dad, brothers, and sisters. They will not only purchase the gifts, but also have them gift wrapped and labeled by volunteers before they take them home.

Vendors are needed to sell inexpensive items for the children to purchase. Volunteers are needed to help younger children shop, wrap gifts, and label them for the children. Donated materials are needed such as wrapping paper, tape, tags, ribbons, and gift boxes for the children to take presents home.

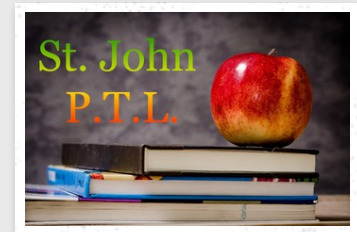


CARE MINISTRY HARVEST SOCIAL
