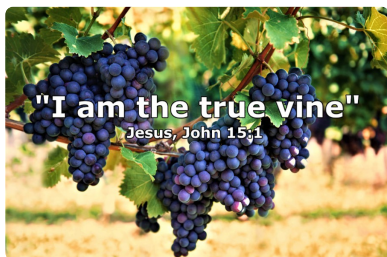

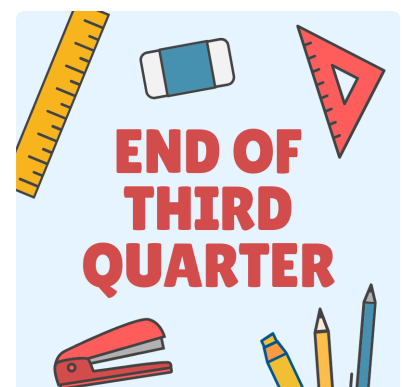
"Connected", John 15:1-5

The next School Board meeting is scheduled for Monday, April 8th, starting at 6:00 in the Church Library.



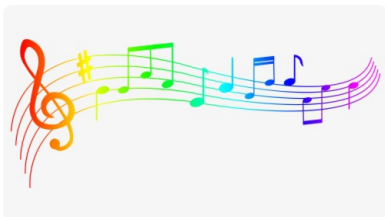
Parents are always welcome to speak to the School Board at the beginning of each meeting. There is time set aside for public input.

Each child made a paper airplane that flew 100 inches or more

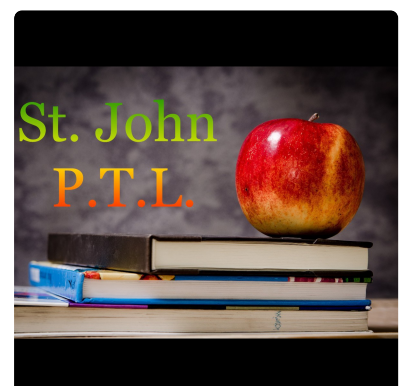


St. John Annual Fish Fry

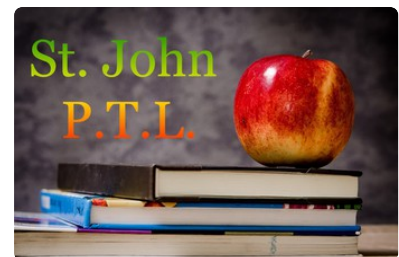

How to make Amazing Easter Egg art!



Our class has been talking about Spring, the new life all around us, and the new life in Christ that we celebrate at Easter. We have been enjoying making art projects that are related to Easter. We painted spring chicks and made butterflies. We rejoice in the Good News from 1 Peter 1:3 – In His great mercy God has given us new birth into living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ.



We talked about many different types of oviparous, {egg laying}, animals and read the book "Chickens Aren't the Only Ones" by Ruth Heller. We enjoyed learning about a ray's egg that is called a mermaid's purse and that God designed the eggs of sea birds, that lay them on rocky ledges, to roll in a circle so they don't roll off the ledge. As a S.T.E.M. activity, students tried making egg shapes that would roll in a circle out of playdough. Although we talked about many egg laying animals, we focused on the life cycle of chickens.
