## Track & Field Day

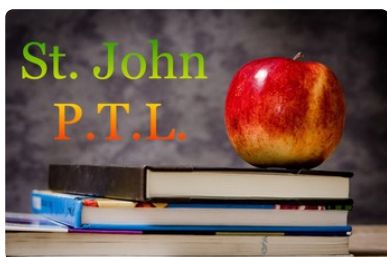
### Thursday May 2nd
