- Last Day for D. C. Everest 4K June 7<sup>th</sup>**

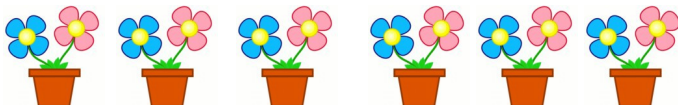
